SUPPORT MEDICAL MISSION TO RESTORE VISION TO UNDERPRIVILEGED PEOPLE OF IBESIKPO ASUTAN COMMUNITY



Dear Sir/Madam:

Ibesikpo/Asutan Organization has been operational as a registered 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organization since 2012. The organization's singular mission is to help meet some very urgent needs of underprivileged children and communities of Ibesikpo Asutan in Akwa Ibom State, Nigeria. Due to the magnitude of these needs, our Organization is targeting critical areas that most desperately need help. The areas include:

1. Improving public health in rural communities through reduction of incidences of Typhoid Fever by providing clean drinking water and providing basic medical services.
2. Promoting the pursuit of

education by supporting infrastructures and improving facilities that create conducive learning environment for the children.

By the end of 2016, our organization raised funds and completed two educational improvement projects in Akwa Ibom State. Our first project involved providing funds for a Nursery/Primary School to drill a borehole, a generator for pumping the water, a large capacity tank for water storage as well as construct and equip a playground for the school children. Our second project involved providing funds for a Lutheran High School to remodel and equip the Home Economics Laboratory with Culinary Utensils and kitchen equipment for students to have practical cooking experiences, particularly those studying to become professional chefs and cooks upon graduation. Completing these projects has demonstrated to our Organization that a little help can go a long way in communities that any form of help is hard to come by.

In 2017, our Organization has aligned itself with a medical group that is travelling to Akwa Ibom State, Nigeria, in March to provide vision correction surgeries and services. We will send along medical supplies and medications with the doctors to help make the operations successful. **We need funding for this project and any amount that you can donate towards our cause will be deeply appreciated.** Being a 501 (c) 3 Non-Profit qualifies your donation to our organization as a tax deduction.
